Introduction

"The <u>Data Protection Act 2018</u> controls how your personal information is used by organisations, businesses or the government.

The Data Protection Act 2018 is the UK's implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Everyone responsible for using personal data has to follow strict rules called 'data protection principles'. They must make sure the information is:

used fairly, lawfully and transparently..."¹

We protect your personal data in compliance with the requirements of the *General Data Protection Act 2018 (UK GDPR)*. The UK *GDPR* requires data controllers such as ourselves to document our lawful basis for processing personal data. It also gives you rights over how your data is processed. Individual Rights

Security

The GDPR requires us to implement appropriate technical measures to protect data. We verify the identity of any individual who requests access to data before granting access. We have a SSL certificate system in place to encrypt any data you supply to us through our website. Additional technical measures are described at the relevant points in this privacy policy.

Disclosures

In addition to any sharing of data described elsewhere in this privacy policy, we may disclose data for legal reasons. If we suspect criminal activity, we may disclose data relating to those involved or affected to the appropriate authorities. We may also be obliged to disclose data if we receive a request from an appropriate authority.

Data collected when you contact us

Contact Form

When you submit an enquiry through a 'Contact Form' on our site, we collect your name, e-mail address, and we safely store your information. We do not share your details with third parties, except for the annotated reasons on this policy i.e. disclosures.

You can ask us to delete your data by contacting us with your request.

Volunteer Applications

Volunteer applications can be downloaded from our website by clicking the link and can be submitted by post or by e-mail. They will be treated with absolute confidentiality and all data will be kept in our manual and electronic files. Data will not be shared with third parties except on the stated exceptions outlined in this policy.

However, unsuccessful applications together with all its data will be appropriately and effectively deleted/destroyed upon its outcome. We do not share your details with third parties, except for the annotated reasons on this policy i.e. disclosures.

Note that you can exercise your right of asking us to delete all information we hold about you at any time.

Data collected when buying from our eBay shop

We only have an eBay account under the name Oldalone UK where we sell donated goods. When you place an order through our eBay shop, we may use your name, e-mail address, telephone number, company, delivery and billing address for the only purpose of delivering your order. We do not store or collect your data which may be dealt with by eBay. Please refer to eBay data privacy policy.

Data collected by third parties on our behalf

Our site is hosted by bOnline Limited (company No.7710947 registered in England and Wales). bOnline logs all requests in order determine the causes of reported faults and to detect and block suspicious traffic. The log records the time of the request, your IP address, the requested resource, the referring site (if specified by your browser), and your browser's user agent string (which will usually include the name and version of your browser and operating system). Log files are deleted after ninety days.
